The Lord must come first

Maintain your walk with Him, not expecting your spouse to do for you what only God can. Ps. 1 | Gal. 5:16 | 1 Pet. 2:2-3 | Jn. 15:5

Laziness will cause your marriage to deteriorate

Pull the weeds (peacemaking) and plant the flowers (connection).

Litigation will turn your marriage into a war zone.

Don't weaponize your spouse's sins and faults through judgment.

Lies are like a deadly cancer to your relationship

Speak the truth in love (even when it hurts) and make it safe for your spouse to share hard things. Eph. 4:15,25 | Prov. 26:28 | James 1:19

Lust can quickly destroy your marriage

Be circumspect in your dealings with the opposite sex and invest in marital intimacy. 2 Tim. 2:22 | James 1:14-15 | Matt. 5:29

Lift one another up to strengthen your marriage

Actively affirm God's good work in your spouse (and go light on criticism).

Build your marriage on Love not Law

Treat your spouse better than they deserve with the same gracious mercy that the Lord shows you. Eph. 3:14-21 | 1 Jn. 4:10-11,19 | 1 Cor. 13:4-7
